Sweet Grass County Commissioner meetings are held in the office of the county commissioners in the Sweet Grass County Annex in Big Timber, Montana, unless otherwise noted in the minutes. The first Monday of each month a department head staff meeting will be held at 9:30 a.m. Claims will be reviewed and approved for payment every Thursday unless a conflict arises. At least one commissioner will be in the office from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily unless they are at a conference or a meeting requiring them to be out of the office.

Monday, May 12, 2025

All Commissioners are in.

The airport FBO called regarding the fueling system at the airport. He hopes to have a new system up and running by this fall. He wondered about some of the infrastructure that will need to be installed prior to connecting the new system.

The City/County quarterly meeting was held. Topics of discussion included: Paving maintenance options that could be shared; West End development timeline; City water storage project; Concerns over blatant subdivision conditions that were being ignored – including septic systems, burning of garbage and other issues of enforcement; Business licensing options; Discussion on city garbage contract and blowing garbage in Dornix Park; City Hall remodel issues; Concerns over the PMC services; SSMC layoff impacts to budget; Disposal of old motor homes and abandoned campers; Lack of a street light on 5th and McLeod near the crosswalk, among others.

Kevin Mitchum with Sibanye Stillwater Mining Company stopped in to review the annual allocation of the Metal Mines License Tax Revenue.

Fire Chief Novotny and Heath Nation of Nation Builders stopped in to discuss concerns over the requirement for an engineered slab and building for the storage of the fire trucks at Melville. They were going to get more information and come up with a plan on how to proceed.
