Monday, September 1, 2025

HOLIDAY - OFFICES CLOSED

Tuesday, September 2, 2025

All Commissioners are in.

The meeting was called to order at 8:58 am, Superintendent of Schools Metcalf presented the rural school budgets and the TFS review and requests. Commissioner Moody moved to accept the submitted budget reports from Melville, Big Timber Grade School, Sweet Grass County High School, Greycliff and McLeod. There were no major changes other than tuition. Commissioner Wallace seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes. The meeting was adjourned at 9:08 am. This meeting was recorded.

The Pioneer Medical Center Human Resources, Financial Officials and Executive Director came in for a meeting to discuss the Public Health Nurse position. They would like the County to provide more funding and to adjust the hours worked, including some time spent at the PMC, as according to their spreadsheet, they lose dollars on the position.

Commissioner Wallace headed out to help the road crew with the Elk Creek Bridge, culvert replacement project.

Wednesday, September 3, 2025

All Commissioners are in.

The meeting was called to order at 9:05 am. Financial Officer Uehling and Clerk & Recorder Curry were also present. Commissioner Wallace moved to adopt Resolution 09-03-2025A - the budget for fiscal year 2025-2026, including an explanation of decreases in the budgets due to 15-10-420, MCA. Commissioner Moody seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes.

Commissioner Moody moved to adopt resolution 09-03-2025B-a resolution to fix the tax levy and fees pursuant to the budget. Commissioner Wallace seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes.

Commissioner Wallace moved to adopt resolution 09-03-2025C – a resolution to set the method of levying voted mills per HB 231 and SB 542. Commissioner Moody seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes.

Commissioner Wallace moved to adopt Resolution 09-03-2025D a resolution to set salaries as recommended by the salary compensation committee per MCA.

Commissioner Moody seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes. The meeting was adjourned. This meeting was recorded.

A brief discussion was held on the lack of response from the Forest Service on the temporary construction permit for the Flemming Bridge.

Peter Fox stopped in to discuss the Montana Passenger Rail Authority and its importance to the county.

John Allen, lead industrial appraiser, Robin Rudd and Peggy Campbell from Montana Department of Revenue came in to discuss Sibanye Stillwater Mining Company and how the gross proceeds had been re-evaluated due to a decline in metals prices and a reduction in production.

Thursday, September 4, 2025

Commissioners Moody and Roe are in the office. Commissioner Wallace is assisting the road crew.

Commissioner Roe called the meeting to order at 9:47 am for the purpose of preparing the agenda for the week of Sept 8th through September 12th. Clerk and Recorder Curry was in. The meeting was adjourned at 9:54 am.

The claims were reviewed and signed for the week.

The Commission called the applicant of an encroachment permit and asked if they were at a point we could put it on the agenda for review and construction approval.

Commissioner Moody received a phone call from a company requesting to do some filming in the county. They were advised of the length of closure and the various regulations.

Road Supervisor Schuman let us know that he has an issue with the Melville Bridge and the north wall.

RESOLUTION #09-03-2025-A

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SWEET GRASS COUNTY FINAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 - 2026

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 7-6-609 and 7-6-4021 MCA, the Board of County Commissioners of Sweet Grass County held a public hearing on the proposed budget for FY 2025 - 2026 on September 3, 2025 at 9:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-6-4030 MCA, requires the Commission to adopt the final budget by resolution. The resolution must!

- (a) Authorize appropriations to defray expenses or liabilities for the fiscal year;
- (b) Establish legal spending limits at the fund level as finally determined;
- (c) Include any increase in property taxes, including an increase authorized under 15-10-420(1) and the amount by which property taxes will increase on homes valued at \$100,00, \$300,000, and \$600,000; and,
- (d) Enter the budget in the official minutes with an effective date of July 1, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, Sweet Grass County received the official Certified Taxable Valuation for 2025 from the Montana Department of Revenue on August 4, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, a Resolution for approving the Final Budget was noticed for consideration on August 21st and August 28th, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the attached Preliminary Budget, which is made a part of this resolution by reference, lists accounts by fund for all appropriations for Sweet Grass County; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Sweet Grass County that the final budget, after any amendments to the preliminary budget and after considering any public comment, is hereby approved and adopted and warrants are issued in accordance with laws appertaining thereto.

This resolution authorizes:

- (a) The following appropriations to defray the expenses or liabilities for the fiscal year.
- (b) A decrease in property taxes due to 15-10-420 (calculations included). Decrease in property tax levy of -\$58.19, -\$174.56, and -\$255.09, respectively for a home valued at \$100,000, \$300,000, and \$600,000 is included in this fiscal year budget.
- (c) A decrease in property taxes due to 15-10-420 (calculations included). Decrease in voted levy of -\$13.28, -\$39.83, and -\$64.80, respectively for a home valued at \$100,000, \$300,000, and \$600,000 is included in this fiscal year budget.
- (d) A decrease in property taxes due to 15-10-420 (calculations included). Decrease in permissive health insurance levy of -\$5.77, -\$17.30, and -\$24.98, respectively for a home valued at \$100,000, \$300,000, and \$600,000 is included in this fiscal year budget.
- (e) It sets the legal spending limits at the county fund level. Fund level detail is stated in the formal budget document and established in the County's accounting system.

A RESOLUTION FOR SWEET GRASS COUNTY FIXING THE TAX LEVY AND FEES PURSUANT TO THE FY 2025-2026 FINAL BUDGET, PURSUANT TO MCA 7-6-4034 AND 7-6-4036 FOR COUNTY-WIDE AND RURAL MILLED FUNDS, AND SPECIAL REVENUE AND CAPITAL FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Sweet Grass County Commission approved a resolution adopting the Final County Budget showing expenses for all departments and activities; and,

WHEREAS, Section 7-6-4034 and 7-6-4036, MCA, requires the County Commission to fix the tax levy for all funds as required to raise sufficient funds to meet said expenditures authorized in the budget; and,

WHEREAS, a Resolution for Fixing Mill Levies was noticed for consideration on August 21 and August 28, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the County Commission held a public hearing on the preliminary Sweet Grass County budget on September 3, 2025; and on the final budget decision; and,

WHEREAS, the County Commission in the preliminary budget calculated the county-wide tax levy limitation to be 155.11 mills, using 155.08 mills and leaving .03 mills "on the table"; calculated the rural tax levy limitation to be 57.60 mills, using 57.54 mills and leaving .06 mills "on the table"; 14.58 mills for the permissive medical levy, and, 22.5 mills for the PMC Facility voted levy; and,

WHEREAS, after receipt of the certified taxable values the Commission determined that the county-wide taxable value is \$27,564,353, a decrease of \$3,139,013 from FY 2025; and the rural taxable value is \$22,799,444, a decrease of \$2,156,374 from FY 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the Montana Department of Revenue did certify the yield of 1 mill for FY 2026 at \$27,564.35 for county-wide mills; and \$22,799.44 for rural mills; and,

WHEREAS, the mill for the statewide school mill levies pursuant to Sections 15-10-420 MCA, has been calculated by the Montana Department of Revenue to be set at a total of 101 mills; and,

WHEREAS, the determination of tax revenue and mill levy limitations under section 15-10-420, MCA, for the aggregate of all county-wide levied funds has been calculated to be \$4,274,773 and 155.08 mills and \$1,311,973 and 57.54 mills for the rural funds levied outside the City of Big Timber; and,

WHEREAS, the statewide school mill levies, calculated by the Montana Department of Revenue, will be 40 mills for state equalization, 33 mills for county elementary equalization, 22 mills for high school equalization, for a total of 95 mills. University mill is 6 mills for a total of 101 mills; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sweet Grass County Commissioners that the attached budget worksheets, which are made a part of this resolution by reference, lists millage by fund for all taxing jurisdictions in Sweet Grass County.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE METHOD OF LEVYING VOTED MILLS PER HB231 AND SB542 PASSED IN THE 2025 MONTANA LEGISLATURE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sweet Grass County, Montana, has determined that voter approved mill levies are required to be recalculated under two new bills passed by the 2025 Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the new legislation requires that voted mills use one of two methods to recalculate the mill levy. The first method starts with the FY2025 assessed tax revenue for the voted levy and applies the formula in MCA 15-10-420 for FY2026 and all future years of the levy. The second method uses the FY2025 assessed tax revenue and calculates the number of mills required to levy that amount of revenue using the FY2026 taxable value. That number of mills is the maximum number of mills to be levied for FY2026 and all future years; and

WHEREAS, Sweet Grass County has the following voter approved mill levies: Pioneer Medical Center 22.5 mills; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by this Board of County Commissioners, that the Pioneer Medical Center 22.5 mill levy will be recalculated by applying the formula in MCA 15-10-420.
