Sweet Grass County Commissioner meetings are held in the office of the county commissioners in the Sweet Grass County Annex in Big Timber, Montana, unless otherwise noted in the minutes. The first Monday of each month a department head staff meeting will be held at 9:30 a.m. Claims will be reviewed and approved for payment every Thursday unless a conflict arises. At least one commissioner will be in the office from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily unless they are at a conference or a meeting requiring them to be out of the office.

Monday, October 20, 2025

All Commissioners are in.

Commissioner Roe went to the Flemming Bridge on Sunday to see what progress had been made.

A discussion was held on the public health nurse position and how to finance it. Primarily revenues come from grants and services rendered with the County picking up the balance. Payroll and oversight are handled through the PMC which is requesting substantially more funding than the commission believes is being spent.

A resident from north of town inquired as to whether or not Donald Road was on the road maintenance schedule in the near future.

Commissioners attended the Bridgemont Mental Health meeting at 1:00 pm.

Commissioner Moody went to the Fairgrounds to check on progress with the new grandstands.

Tuesday, October 21, 2025

All Commissioners are in.

The Commission called Rinker Materials, the supplier of the bridge beams for the Flemming Bridge to follow up on production and scheduling.

The Commission talked to the Cemetery Caretaker about the maintenance position and how much time is spent at the cemeteries, the courthouse and the annex on maintenance, snow removal, lawn care and general issues.

Wednesday, October 22, 2025

Commissioners Moody and Roe are in the office. Commissioner Wallace attended the MACRs grader training to enhance his already incredible grader skills. 😊

The Commission called a local equipment dealer to discuss a brush hog implement and whether or not it would be more equitable to rent it or buy it.

One of the airport board members came in to discuss an issue with NW Energy's power line running directly under the pad where the fueling station is slated to be located.

An encroachment permit was received from Engineering West on behalf of Phyllis Kemph on the Susie Creek Subdivision.

The Commission meeting was called to order at 2:12 pm to prepare the agenda for the week of October 27th through October 31st, 2025. The meeting was adjourned at 2:20 pm. This meeting was recorded.
