Sweet Grass County Commissioner meetings are held in the office of the county commissioners in the Sweet Grass County Annex in Big Timber, Montana, unless otherwise noted in the minutes. The first Monday of each month a department head staff meeting will be held at 9:30 a.m. Claims will be reviewed and approved for payment every Thursday unless a conflict arises. At least one commissioner will be in the office from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily unless they are at a conference or a meeting requiring them to be out of the office.

Monday, December 8, 2025

All Commissioners are in.

Megan Spry replied to our inquiries about the Sanitarian position and gave us a couple of options depending on her schedule.

The Commission asked the president of the airport board if he would be available for a meeting to discuss pre-design at the airport for upcoming projects.

A board member of the Chamber of Commerce stopped in to visit about the chamber director opening.

Tuesday, December 9, 2025

All Commissioners are in.

Planner Dringman was in to present several COS and Subdivision reviews. The Commission was called to order at 10:01 am by Chairman Roe.

1. Commissioner Moody moved to approve the Eisen/Duschene COS/boundary adjustment exchange. Commissioner Wallace seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes.
2. Commissioner Wallace moved to approve the Roe Certificate of Survey boundary relocation and alignment. Commissioner Moody seconded and the motion carried with 2 ayes. Commissioner Roe recused herself due to a conflict of interest.
3. Commissioner Wallace moved to acknowledge and approve the Kempf retracement. Commissioner Moody seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes.
4. Commissioner Moody moved to approve the boundary relocation and Certificate of Survey for the Beach/Headstrom property on Shanks Basin East and the Easy Gone Ranch.
5. Commissioner Moody moved to accept the Klein Subdivision with covenants reviewed. Commissioner Wallace seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes.

Commissioner Wallace moved to approve the Kempf Susie Creek subdivision. Planner Dringman presented the DEQ approval and the updated covenants. Commissioner Moody seconded. The motion carried with three ayes. However, the paperwork was not signed by the Commission due to the lack of a signature by the owner. When she is able to sign, the Commission will sign. The meeting was adjourned. This meeting was recorded.
